Rev. Dr. Scott Field served as the pastor of Wheatland Salem United Methodist Church in Naperville from 1980 – 2013. During his tenure the congregation experienced the joys and pains of transition from a ready-to-close country church to a large, globally involved, suburban, multi-staff congregation serving at two locations. While at Wheatland Salem, Pastor Field estimates that he actually served as the pastor of at least six different churches during his tenure as Sr. Pastor of that congregation. Currently Pastor Field is appointed as Lead Pastor of First United Methodist Church in Crystal Lake, IL with a ministry focused on leading a new chapter of renewal and re-engagement in the mission and ministry of the congregation. Beyond the local church, Pastor Field is an Adjunct Faculty Member of Northern Seminary in Lombard, IL and on the teaching faculty of the International Leadership Institute with a focus on leadership development among pastors in India.



Pastor Field has a long-standing involvement with evangelical renewal efforts in the United Methodist Church and served to coordinate those efforts at seven General Conferences of The United Methodist Church.

Pastor Field is a graduate of Hope College in Holland, MI (B.A.), Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary (M.Div.), the Divinity School of Duke University (Th.M), Asbury Theological Seminary (D.Min.). In addition, he holds Graduate Certification in Organizational Change Management from North Central College in Naperville.
